Results















Results for Home management Malaria

January – December 2016

- ♦ 143,427 people had access to the HMM program
- → > 450 community members trained as volunteers
- ♦ 151,533 presentation of fever & RDT preformed
- ♦ 50,254 people tested + and were provided with treatment







Home management of Malaria

Through the HMM program we have:

- ✓ Increased the number of people being tested for malaria
- ✓ Ensured treatment is only provided to people who have a + RDT and therefore have malaria
- ✓ Reduced time of onset of symptoms & receiving treatment
- Decreased burden of care at health facilities
- ✓ Decreased number of hospitalizations resulting from malaria
- ✓ And therefore reduced the burden of malaria in the community
